This guide provides detailed instructions on how to install and set up NetWrix Non-Owner Mailbox Access Reporter for Exchange. It lists all product requirements and guides you through the installation process.

This guide can be used by system integrators and administrators.

For information on how to configure and use the product, refer to <u>NetWrix Non-Owner Mailbox Access Reporter for Exchange Administrator's Guide</u>.

2. DEPLOYMENT OPTIONS

NetWrix Non-Owner Mailbox Access Reporter for Exchange can be installed on any computer in the forest, but it is not recommended to install it on a domain controller. If you want to monitor Exchange servers located in different forests, a separate instance of NetWrix Non-Owner Mailbox Access Reporter for Exchange must be installed in each forest. If you wish to monitor several Exchange servers located in one forest, you do not have to install several instances of the product (one per each Exchange server). You can specify the credentials of a domain or enterprise administrator for collecting data (for details on how to specify these credentials, refer to Chapter 3 Configuring Non-Owner Mailbox Access Reporter for Exchange of NetWrix Non-Owner Mailbox Access Reporter for Exchange Administrator's Guide).

3. INSTALLATION PREREQUISITES

This chapter lists all hardware and software requirements for the installation of NetWrix Non-Owner Mailbox Access Reporter for Exchange. It also provides information on the requirements to the monitored environment.

3.1. Hardware Requirements

Before installing NetWrix Non-Owner Mailbox Access Reporter for Exchange, make sure that your system meets the following hardware requirements:

Table 1: Non-Owner Mailbox Access Reporter for Exchange Hardware Requirements

Component	Minimum	Recommended
Processor	Intel or AMD 32 bit, 2GHz	Intel or AMD 64 bit, 3GHz
Memory	512MB RAM	2GB RAM
Disk	50MB physical disk space for the installation	200MB physical disk space for the installation

3.2. Software Requirements

This section lists the minimum software requirements for NetWrix Non-Owner Mailbox Access Reporter for Exchange. Make sure that this software has been installed before proceeding with the installation.

3.3. Requirements to the Environment

The following requirements apply to the environment that you are going to monitor:

Component	Requirement
Exchange Server	Exchange Server 2003, 2007, 2010
Framework	.NET Framework <u>2.0</u> , <u>3.0</u> or <u>3.5</u>
	NOTE: Only required if you select to use agents for data collection and receive detailed reports.

4. INSTALLING NETWRIX NON-OWNER MAILBOX ACCESS REPORTER FOR EXCHANGE

To install NetWrix Non-Owner Mailbox Access Reporter for Exchange, perform the following procedure:

Procedure 1. To install NetWrix Non-Owner Mailbox Access Reporter for Exchange

- 1. <u>Download</u> NetWrix Non-Owner Mailbox Access Reporter for Exchange.
- 2. Run the setup package called nombafull_setup.msi.
- 3. Follow the instructions of the installation wizard.
- 4. When prompted, accept the license agreement and specify the installation folder.
- 5. On the last step, click **Finish** to complete the installation.

NetWrix Non-Owner Mailbox Access Reporter for Exchange shortcut will be added to your **Start** menu.

Note: NetWrix Non-Owner Mailbox Access Reporter for Exchange runs as a sheduled task, therefore it is not necessary to keep the program open once it has been configured.

5. UPGRADING FROM PREVIOUS VERSIONS

To upgrade NetWrix Non-Owner Mailbox Access Reporter for Exchange to the latest released version, perform the following procedure:

Procedure 2. To upgrade NetWrix Non-Owner Mailbox Access Reporter for Exchange

- 1. <u>Download</u> the latest version of NetWrix Non-Owner Mailbox Access Reporter for Exchange.
- 2. Run the downloaded installation package.

NetWrix Non-Owner Mailbox Access Reporter for Exchange will be updated automatically. All current product settings, including the report and notification templates, will be preserved during the upgrade and no re-configuration is required.

6. UNINSTALLING NETWRIX NON-OWNER MAILBOX ACCESS REPORTER FOR EXCHANGE

To uninstall NetWrix Non-Owner Mailbox Access Reporter for Exchange from your computer, perform the following procedure:

Procedure 3. To uninstall NetWrix Non-Owner Mailbox Access Reporter for Exchange

- Navigate to Start → Control Panel → Programs and Features (for Windows Vista or Windows 7) or Start → Control Panel → Add or Remove Programs (for Windows XP or Windows 2003).
- 2. In the **Program and Features / Add or Remove Programs** dialog, proceed to **NetWrix Non-Owner Mailbox Access Reporter for Exchange** and double-click it.
- 3. Click Yes in the confirmation dialog. NetWrix Non-Owner Mailbox Access Reporter for Exchange uninstallation wizard will start.

The program will be deleted automatically.

If you used agents to collect information from your Exchange servers, it is necessary to remove them manually. The agents are stopped during the uninstallation process, but are not deleted.

To remove the agents, perform the following procedure on every computer where a monitored Exchange server is installed:

Procedure 4. To remove the agents

- 1. Navigate to Start \rightarrow Run. Type cmd in the entry field.
- 2. In the Command Prompt window, type sc delete "NetWrix Non-owner Mailbox Access Agent" and press Enter. The agent will be deleted.
- 3. Delete the following folder: c:\windows\NetWrix\NetWrix Non-owner Mailbox Access Agent.
