





## Summary: Limitations of Native Auditing Tools

### NetWrix Logon Reporter vs Built-in Tools

Feature	Logon Reporter	Event Viewer
Reports that show WHO, WHEN, WHERE made logon or logoff		Difficult to analyze because event logs contain a lot of low-level information and noise
Automatic daily e-mail reports showing all logon and logoff events made during the last day		
Prevents the loss of audit data caused by event log overwrites		No, defined by maximum log size and generally can hold no more than a week of audit records. Can enable automatic archiving of event logs when they are full, but need to clean them or otherwise they will fill up all available disk space.
Audit data consolidation		Ability to analyze events only on one machine at a time (no centralized audit data archive).
Predefined compliance reports		
Long-term archiving	Yes, saves events to highly compressed file-based storage that can hold multiple years of audit data without performance issues.	Practically No
Subscriptions to reports	Yes. Integration with Microsoft SQL Server Standard or Enterprise Edition is required.
